Please see the below email from Todd Frerichs with the Army ROTC Program regarding a scholarship for Class of 2021.

Due to the unique environment we are in, we feel it is important to reach out to the class of 2021. The intent is for the students to gain information about the Army ROTC scholarship process. The scholarship application is currently open. Students who complete the application can earn a full tuition and fee scholarship to more than 1,700 colleges nationwide. Some colleges are unique in that they will give free room and board to Army ROTC scholarship awardees. Creighton University is one example of that. If a student comes to Creighton on a 4-year Army Scholarship, the student pays zero out of pocket expense to earn their degree.

Timing is important for this program. The first board meets in October, so it is vital that those who desire to apply have the information on the process and requirements before September 10th. This will ensure they have enough time to complete the online application and ensure all other requirements; physical fitness test, transcript requested / submitted, and Officer interview are turned in timely.

A few other counselors have helped by sending this information out to their seniors on our behalf via email.
